DESERT

Also the desert is divided into two basic types -- the Mojave (high desert) and the Colorado (which is low). Death Valley, the hottest, driest desert in California, and the lowest point in the United States, is located in the Basin and Range region. Some of the nation's highest temperatures have been recorded in Death Valley.

To begin with, the desert has little rainfall in making it difficult for the land to sustain most plant life. They are known for extreme climates, with temperatures soaring in the daytime and then dropping to freezing levels in the night. Death Valley and Joshua Tree are two national parks that are found within California's desert region. Yucca, cactus, sagebrush, wildflowers, and Mesquite grow well in Death Valley dry, sandy soil.
